

II BILINGUAL CONTEST FACEPM - RED CROSS

For the second consecutive year Colegio "El Valle" has had the chance to put forward our Primary and first cycle of Secondary Education students to compete in the contest organized by FACEPM (The Federation of Private Schools of Madrid) and by the Red Cross.
